**Norwood Forum** is run by annually elected local volunteers dedicated to fostering a sustainable, vibrant, and healthy community. Our goal is to make a meaningful difference to the quality of life for everyone who lives, studies and works in Norwood.

The area we cover is the south-east corner of the London Borough of Lambeth: West Norwood, Gipsy Hill and Tulse Hill – referred to collectively as 'Norwood'.

The Norwood Forum Committee comprises up to 15 members: the Officers of the Forum (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary and Treasurer) with the remaining serving as ordinary Committee Members. The Committee is responsible for overseeing and managing the Forum and is directly accountable to the wider Forum membership.

Please note, as set out in our [Constitution](#) (para.6e): "Any individual being proposed for election or serving as a member of the Forum committee should have regard to the Constitution and policies of the Forum. In respect of the Conflict of Interest Policy, the individual must consider and declare on their nomination form any actual, potential, or perceived conflicts of interest that may affect their ability to act in the best interests of the Forum. This includes financial, personal, or professional interests. The Committee reserves the right to request further information from nominees regarding their application to serve on the Committee or as an officer, including information regarding association with Norwood, previous experience or expertise that may be relevant, and possible conflicts of interest. Nominees agree to make available relevant information for consideration by the Committee and Forum."

The new committee will be elected at the Norwood Forum AGM which will be held between 1.15pm-1.45pm in the Library Community Room as part of the Norwood Green Day on Saturday 13 June, 11am-3pm at West Norwood Library & Picturehouse, 1-5 Norwood High St, SE27 9JX. At the first committee meeting following this AGM, the new Officers will be elected.

If any nominations are rejected, the Secretary will advise the person concerned accordingly.
